3. Interactions of health determinants – elderly, BMI, EoL, AKI, OSA, stroke, cognitive impairment

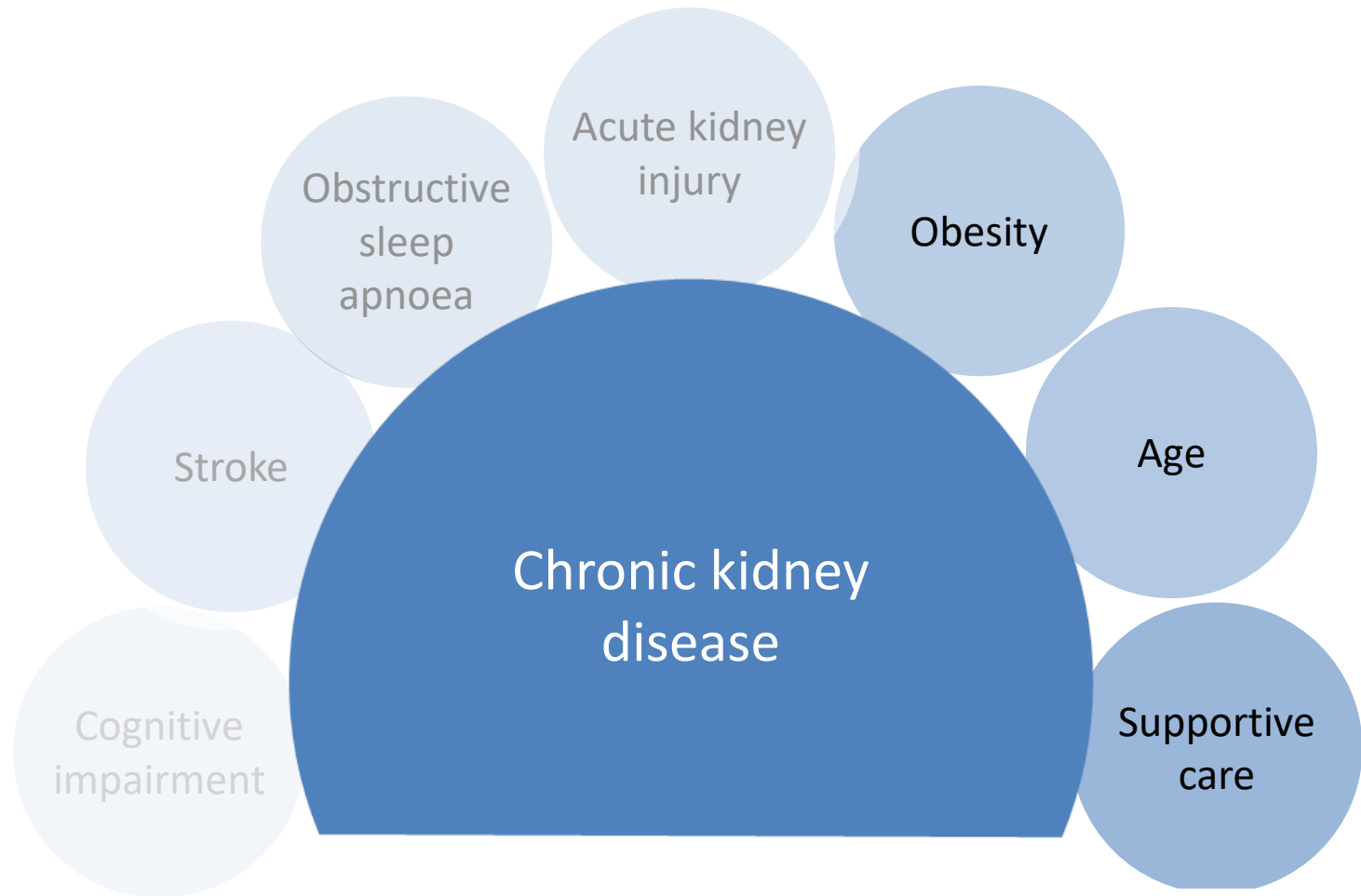
